Advancement Rules:

Note: If *you* feel you should advance to the next higher class but the advancement rules don't *force* you to - please do so anyway, we encourage riders to challenge themselves.

1. ANY rider who finishes in the Top Ten Overall for the previous race season must ride in an Expert class.
2. The top 2 in both Beginner classes must move up to a Novice class.
3. Senior A vs. B: At least the top 5 of the '09 Senior class must ride in the new Senior A class. If you feel you are of the "faster group" of the existing Senior class then ride in the Senior A class. If you are a Senior A rider in another off-road series, you need to ride in the Senior A class. If you are an Intermediate or A MX rider you need to ride in the A class.
